- A Notice of Dissolution should be accompanied by a completed final Disclosure Report, current to the date of dissolution.
- Final Reports must show disposition of campaign property with a value of \$25 or more on Schedule H, and all debts and obligations of the committee paid or satisfied.
- Leftover funds (including those from sale of campaign property) must be distributed according to the statement of intent on the most recently filed Statement of Organization as permitted by Iowa Code §56.42.
