HEREIN, pursuant to Iowa Code section 68B.32C a contested case hearing will be held before Presiding Officer Gerald Sullivan. The hearing is scheduled for 10:45 a.m. on September 1, 2006. The hearing will be held telephonically. The Respondent shall provide the Board's Legal Counsel by August 28, 2006, a telephone where she will be available for the hearing.

**ALLEGATION**

1. The Respondent was Director of Operations for the Iowa Telecommunications and Technology Commission during all or part of calendar year 2005.
2. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 68B.35, the Respondent was required to file a Personal Financial Disclosure statement. Pursuant to Board rule 351—7.1(68B), the statement was required to be filed on or before April 30, 2006 (extended to May 1, 2006, as April 30, 2006, fell on a weekend). The Respondent has failed to file the statement despite notice to do so.

Both parties may present evidence, call witnesses, and enter motions. The Respondent may be represented by counsel at his own expense. The Board's Legal Counsel is responsible for proving the allegation. The allegation in this matter must be proven by clear and convincing evidence. Any proven allegation is subject to the possible imposition of Board sanctions under Iowa Code section 68B.32D. Copies of filings should be addressed to Board Legal Counsel:

The Board's jurisdiction and authority are provided in Iowa Code chapter 68B. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the procedural rules in 351—Chapter 11. Pursuant to 351—11.8(3), within 10 days of service of this notice either party may request that the presiding officer be an administrative law judge assigned by the Department of Inspections and Appeals. The procedure for settlement of this matter is governed by rule 351—9.5.
