



## Response to DE Employee Request for Consent to Sell

**Employee Name and Job Title:** Jan Davis; Supervisor, Rehabilitation

**Determination<sup>1</sup>:** Consent granted without condition

### Summary of Request and Rationale for Determination:

Jan Davis seeks permission to sell the service of teaching undergraduate classes at Buena Vista University (BVU) in sociology and psychology research methods, biological psychology, and crisis intervention.

As a private postsecondary institution, BVU is not regulated by the Iowa Department of Education (IDE) with the exception of the practitioner preparation programs offered by BVU. Ms. Davis is not a member of IDE staff whose responsibility it is to review, assess, and recommend for approval practitioner preparation programs. She has no duties at IDE that place her in a position of authority over BVU.

Therefore, the sale of the service of teaching the aforementioned courses for Buena Vista University will not cause Jan Davis to advocate on behalf of any entity, does not benefit or prejudice any regulated person or entity, and does not result in a conflict of interest per section 68B.2A.
