



## Response to DE Employee Request for Consent to Sell

**Employee Name and Job Title:** Ann Petersen, Rehabilitation Counselor

**Determination<sup>1</sup>:** Consent granted without condition

### Summary of Request and Rationale for Determination:

Ann Petersen seeks permission to sell the service of teaching undergraduate classes at Iowa Lakes Community College (ILCC).

All community colleges in Iowa, including ILCC, are regulated by the Iowa Department of Education (IDE), Bureau of Community Colleges within the Division of Community Colleges and Workforce Preparation. Ms. Petersen works for a division within the IDE that has no regulatory oversight of community colleges.

Therefore, the sale of the service of teaching any courses for ILCC will not cause Ann Petersen to advocate on behalf of any entity, does not benefit or prejudice any regulated person or entity, and does not result in a conflict of interest per section 68B.2A.
