



Response to DE Employee Request for Consent to Sell

Determination¹: Consent granted without condition

Summary of Request and Rationale for Determination:

Kelley Rice seeks permission to sell the service of teaching undergraduate classes at Des Moines Area Community College (DMACC) in Family Law and Debtor/Creditor Law.

All community colleges in Iowa, including DMACC, are regulated by the Iowa Department of Education (IDE), Bureau of Community Colleges within the Division of Community Colleges and Workforce Preparation. Dr. Rice is the attorney for a division within the IDE that has no regulatory oversight of community colleges.

Therefore, the sale of the service of teaching the above courses will not cause Kelley Rice to advocate on behalf of any entity, does not benefit or prejudice any regulated person or entity, and does not result in a conflict of interest per section 68B.2A.
