Summary of Request and Rationale for Determination:

Stefanie Rosenberg Wager, a social studies education consultant, seeks timely permission to sell the service of being a Grant Director for the Iowa Council for Social Studies (ICSS) for a grant received from the Library of Congress to conduct workshops using materials from the Library of Congress. Ms. Wager will coordinate a two-day workshop, follow-up webinars, and establish a website dedicated to the grant.

This agency does not regulate the Iowa Council for Social Studies, which is a private professional organization, or the Library of Congress. Ms. Wager will provide this service outside of her regular working hours and does not conflict with her job duties at the Iowa Department of Education (IDE).

Therefore, the sale of the service of being a Grant Director for ICSS will not cause Ms. Wager to advocate on behalf of any entity, does not benefit, or prejudice any regulated person or entity, and does not result in a conflict of interest per section 68B.2A.
