





Summary of Request and Rationale for Determination:

Duane (D.T.) Magee seeks permission to sell the service of refereeing youth basketball games for Sportsplex West located at 890 SE Olson Dr., Waukee, Iowa. This would occur in his off worktime.

The Iowa Department of Education (IDE) and the Iowa Board of Educational Examiners (BOEE) do not regulate this entity or have a business relationship with this entity. Nor does the BOEE have any oversight over youth sports referees.

Therefore, the sale of the service of refereeing youth basketball games does not cause Duane (D.T.) Magee to advocate on behalf of any entity, does not benefit or prejudice any regulated person or entity, and does not result in a conflict of interest per section 68B.2A.
