Dear Mr. Smithson:

In accordance with Iowa Code (IC) section 68B.4 the Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) granted consent for Angela Leek, staff of OUR Bureau of Radiological Health (BRH) to sell goods and services as follows:

1. Ms. Leek may sell goods or services on x-ray imaging continuing education to any individual, association, or corporation regulated by the BRH. This consent is granted because such sale of goods or services does not affect her duties or functions as a Health Physicist with the BRH.
2. Individual application and approval are not required for the sale of goods or services unless there are unique facts surrounding a particular sale which would cause the sale to affect the seller's duties with BRH, would give the buyer an advantage in dealing with BRH staff or would otherwise present a conflict of interest as defined in IC section 68B.2A or the common law.
3. Individual application and approval, when required, shall conform to the procedures and guidelines outlined in 351-Iowa Administrative Code 6.11, and shall only be granted by management of the Department.

CONSENT TO SALES OF GOODS AND SERVICES

Under the provision of Chapter 136C of the Iowa Code, the Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) is granted authority to regulate the use of all sources of ionizing radiation in Iowa other than sources used at federal facilities having sole federal jurisdiction. Within IDPH the Bureau of Radiological Health (BRH) regulates continuing education required of persons who operate x-ray equipment on human beings as set forth in Chapter 641-Chapter 42 of the Iowa Administrative Code. Pursuant to Iowa Code section 68B.4 Agency officials and employees shall not sell or lease, either directly or indirectly, any goods or services to individuals, associations, or corporations that are subject to the regulatory authority of the IDPH except as authorized by Iowa Code section 68B.4 and the administrative rules adopted by the Iowa Ethics and Campaign Disclosure Board, 351 Iowa Administrative Code 6.11.

On the 31st day of July, 2006, the BRH granted consent for Angela Leek to sell goods and services as follows:

1. Ms. Leek may sell goods and services on x-ray imaging continuing education to any individual, association or corporation regulated by BRH. This consent is granted because such sale of goods and services does not affect her duties or functions as a Health Physicist with IDPH.
2. Individual applications and approvals are not required for the sale of goods or services unless there are unique facts surrounding a particular sale which would cause the sale to affect the seller's duties at the BRH, would give the buyer an advantage in dealing with BRH staff or would otherwise present a conflict of interest as defined in Iowa Code section 68B.2A on the common law.
3. Individual application and approval, when required, shall conform to the procedures and guidelines outlined in 351 Iowa Administrative Code 6.11, and shall only be granted by management of IDPH.
