





I wish to report to you and the board that the Iowa Medical & Classification Center has received a bequest from the estate of Jeanne Funkhouser Reeder.

The distribution was in accordance with the will as established by the person noted above and handled through the US Bank located in Cedar Rapids. The distribution amount received is \$43,087.27. A copy of that check is enclosed as is the court order.

The bequest as stated under Article X, section 6:

“Fifteen Percent for improvements in the tragic, dire living conditions of mentally-ill prisoners at the Oakdale Facility, North Liberty, Iowa – or elsewhere.....”

The check has not been deposited as yet pending instructions, comments, interrogatories or other conditions as may be established by the board, state auditor’s office and the Department of Corrections.
