On May 19, 2005 the Iowa Ethics and Campaign Disclosure Board determined that your committee failed to timely file a Statement of Organization, the January 19, 2005 campaign disclosure report, and a Notice of Dissolution as required by Iowa Code sections 68A.201, 68A.402, and 68A.402B. The Board did review your request for waiver of the \$100 civil penalty assessed for the late filing of the report and voted to waive the civil penalty and in lieu of issue this Letter of Reprimand for the late report, late Statement of Organization, and late Notice of Dissolution.

A reprimand serves as the Board's mildest sanction and is considered discipline for violating the law. The reprimand will be placed in the appropriate public disclosure files. If there is another violation in the future, the Board will take into consideration the fact your committee received this Reprimand.

Pursuant to rule 351—9.4(3), you may appeal the issuance of this Reprimand by submitting within 30 days a written request for a contested case proceeding.
