On May 19, 2005, the Iowa Ethics and Campaign Disclosure Board determined that your committee failed to file true and accurate campaign reports by not disclosing debts or estimated debts in violation of Iowa Code section 68A.402 and rule 351—4.16 and issues this Letter of Reprimand.

A reprimand serves as the Board's mildest sanction and is considered discipline for violating the law. The reprimand will be placed in the appropriate public disclosure files. If there is another violation in the future, the Board will take into consideration the fact your committee received this Reprimand.

Pursuant to rule 351—9.4(3), you may appeal the issuance of this Reprimand by submitting within 30 days a written request for a contested case proceeding.
